

Examination Schedule and Promotion Rules

Evaluation is as important as teaching. The unique evaluation system of DAV is devised to develop in the child the habit of being regular, systematic and methodical. These evaluations serve as incentives to hard work and have their diagnostic value both for the teachers and the taught, spread over the whole year of knowledge and learning. Emphasis is laid on objectivity of the concept and the various skills associated with concept of teaching and learning. Question papers are set to make the examination reliable and comprehensive. The activities, projects and home tasks are given special weightage for promotion.

A student is required to score minimum of 33% in individual subject and also in aggregate to be declared promoted. In this regard the amended rules from CBSE, New Delhi will be applied for classes VI to XII. However, we will tend to follow the No detention policy as issued by CBSE/State Govt. for the classes upto Std. VIII.

As CBSE abolished the CCE scheme from session 2017-18, the examination schedule has been re-designed for the classes V to X. The promotion of a student will be based on the amended rules from CBSE which may be circulated by the school time to time.

Proposed Examination Schedule: Class LKG to XII (2026-27)

Assessment Schedule: Class LKG - II

- * The Assessment of the students of Classes LKG to II will be based on observations by the MT as per EEDP Guidelines issued by DAV CAE New Delhi.
- * There will be "No Pen Paper test" and Observations Based Assessment will be done in 3 periodic assessments.
- * **First Periodic:** April to August 2026, **Second Periodic:** Sept to Dec 2026 and **Third Periodic:** Jan to March 2027.

Examination Schedule : Class III & IV

- * Student of Classes III and IV will be assessed by four Periodic Test (PT-I, Term-I/HY, PT-III, Term-II/Annual) will be conducted at the School level each covering PT-I / PT-III 25% & Term - I / Term - II 50% syllabus as per the zonal schedule.

- All the examination dates are tentative and subject to change as per the directives from competent authority.
- For Class IX, one periodic test (before Half Yearly) with 25% and another periodic test (after Half Yearly) 25% syllabus will be conducted at the school level. PT - II / Half Yearly, Mock test and Annual Exams will be conducted as Common Zonal Examination as per the CBSE Syllabus.
- For Class IX and X, Best two performances out of the three-periodic tests will be considered for awarding Internal Assessment of the student.
- For Class VIII & IX (Mock Test) and X & XII, Pre-board exams will be conducted as Common Zonal Exams before the Annual Exam.
- Marks Weightage : Class-XI - 10% of UT, 30% of Half Yearly and 60% of Annual Exam will be added to for the compilation of final result.
- The deficiency in working days which may arise due to specified functions in a school like Sports/Annual Day/Conduction of inter school activity etc. must be compensated at the school level by organizing extra/remedial classes.
